NATIONAL AGRICULTURAL AND RURAL INCLUSIVE GROWTH PROJECT (NARIGP)

IMPLEMENTATION STATUS REPORT-MAY 2023

National Agricultural and Rural Inclusive Growth Project (NARIGP) is a Government of Kenya initiative funded by National Government, County Government and the World Bank.

Embu County is one of the 21 NARIG project implementing counties and is classified among the Semi-Arid counties. The project covers the 4 sub-Counties (Manyatta, Runyenjes, Mbeere North and Mbeere South) and is implemented in all the 20 wards.

The Project Development Objective (PDO): to increase agricultural productivity and profitability of targeted rural communities in selected counties, and in the event of an Eligible Crisis or Emergency, to provide immediate and effective response"

 The four prioritized value chains with the potential to attain the project development objective are Dairy Cow, Chicken, Mangoes and Green grams.
 Coffee has been included as an additional value chain under the Coffee Revitalization Programme (CRP).

The projected direct beneficiaries across the county are 18,670 households.

The Project consists of 4 components:

- 1. Supporting Community-Driven Development
- 2. Strengthening Producer Organizations and Value Chain Development
- 3. Supporting County Community-Led Development
- 4. Project Management Coordination, Monitoring & Evaluation
